Everything you wanted to know about our events & membership (The FAQ)

What kind of things do you do?

In the past few years we've done all sorts of activities: hiking, camping, kayaking, indoor rock climbing, softball, volleyball, skiing, ultimate frisbee, spelunking (caving), and other outdoor stuff. We also have an occasional social gathering or two.

Do I need to be a member to come on an event?

Actually, anyone is welcome to join us; in fact, we encourage it! Members do receive certain benefits, however. In addition, the financial support you give us by paying your annual dues is what enables us to pay for publicity, the web site, and email lists. Please contact us and join today. It's only \$5!

Is everybody in the group Jewish/single?

Jewish, pretty much so (Arizona has many outdoor clubs that aren't Jewish). Single, not everybody. We're first and foremost a Jewish outdoor club. Singles like us because we're not the typical singles scene. One of our strengths is that many friends stay active with us even after they're married or join a committed relationship.

How many people attend your events?

Attendance varies greatly based on the type of event, time of year, etc. Our hikes range from a handful to around twenty people (which is the practical limit for most hiking groups, if not less). Our softball games are ideally around twenty. Parties are about the only event where it truly is “the more the merrier”.

How old is everyone in the group?

Membership is heavily weighted towards the 20s and 30s, yet we're proud of our 40-something-plus friends who are in such great shape that they run laps around people half their age.

Can I bring my child, pet, non-Jewish friend, etc.?

Participation is at the discretion of the person who is leading the event. **Ask in advance.**

Are the hikes difficult?

All of our hikes are rated on a scale of difficulty from A to D (see the table below). The hike leader has often done the hike before and is knowledgeable about the distance and elevation change. Please be responsible for your own well being. Don't over-exert yourself; but one can often go a little further with motivation from a group – that's how you improve! Look for these ratings in the schedule:

A	DIFFICULT. Over 16 miles or over 3000-ft elevation change.
B	MODERATE. 8 to 16 miles and 1500 to 3000-ft elevation change.
C	BEGINNER. 3 to 8 miles and 500 to 1500-ft elevation change.
D	EASY. Under 3 miles and less than 500-ft elevation change.

Where and when do we meet? Do I need to RSVP?

As noted, **always** call the event leader who is listed for further information. Please let these people know whether or not you will attend so that they may plan ahead. If you don't RSVP early you run the risk of not being aware of a change in plans such as event time or meeting location. **RSVP EARLY** – not the day or night before!!

What should I bring? Food? Water?

The event leader will notify you if you should bring special items, such as backpacks, lunch, or warm clothing. You should always plan on bringing water (2 quarts or more) and snack food. It's also a good idea to bring extra cash for lunch or dinner during or after the event. If there is any question as to what to bring or how difficult the event is, call and discuss this with the leader. Please plan ahead for driving time to the meeting location so that we may start on time.

How do we get to the events?

Our events sometimes begin somewhere outside of the Phoenix area, especially in the summer, when we often go well north of the Phoenix area to escape the heat. We try to carpool, meeting at some convenient location first. From there, drivers volunteer and the passengers contribute money for gas plus wear-and-tear based on mileage. We currently use a rate of \$0.06 per passenger per mile. So please bring a enough cash to help out the drivers. Visa, Master Card, and American Express are **not** accepted.

Most importantly...
